Greetings from ASCLS-Montana:

The annual convention and business meeting of the American Society for Clinical Laboratory Science-Montana is scheduled for April 14-17th at the Doubletree Edgewater Hotel, in Missoula, Montana. We will be **“Exploring the Rivers of Change”** and hope you will be able to join us.

Exhibit times and social events begin with the Wednesday evening social, April 14th. Thursday will include lunch and evening sessions with the exhibitors. The exhibit sessions will wrap up with lunch on Friday April 16th. Each exhibit registration receives an eight-foot area, which includes an 8-foot table and covering, and an electrical outlet. The cost per booth is \$400.00. If needed, an additional 8-foot space can be purchased for \$200.00. If you are an exhibitor with an outside van, you must contact me personally, as space is limited.

Information about the type of display to be presented in your exhibit area is requested to assist in the layout of the exhibit floor. Please indicate the number of electrical outlets required, instrumentation to be displayed and the electrical requirements. **Remember to bring your own electrical extension cords as we will not be able to provide them for you.** The exhibit room will be locked and secured during non-exhibit hours.

Please see the attached registration form and register as quickly as possible as space is limited. To assure that your company name is listed in the convention program, register before March 1, 2010. Payment must accompany the registration. Make checks payable to ASCLS-Montana.

The Doubletree Edgewater Hotel has reserved a block of rooms for this convention at a great price of \$85 single, \$95 double (non river view) with an additional cost for river view rooms.
